

DEED MAPS
(so called)

Deed maps are maps attached to and made a part of deeds or documents which are then recorded in the office of the County Recorder of the county in which the land is located.

These maps either supplement or are used in lieu of the legal description of the lands covered by the deed, and upon approval of authorized personnel of the Title Company may be referred to in a legal description as follows:

"That certain parcel shown as _____ (or "Parcel _____) in the (City of _____), County of Los Angeles, State of California on a map attached to and made a part of the deed recorded in book _____ page _____ of Deeds, (or of Official Records) in the office of the County Recorder of said County."
